What we do

We have delivered nearly 100,000 shelters to 90 countries in the Middle East, Africa, Europe, South East Asia, and the Americas.


Relief Housing Unit (RHU)

A resistant shelter that arrives with all parts in a flatpack and is easy to assemble for immediate safety and dignity in emergency response.



RHU Structure

A sustainable shelter that can be upgraded and lasts throughout the duration of displacement beyond its basic purpose as emergency shelter.
